

The IEEE International Conference on Software Architecture (ICSA 2019) is the premier gathering of practitioners and researchers interested in software architecture, in component-based software engineering and in quality aspects of complex software systems. ICSA is a working conference, where researchers meet practitioners and where software architects can explain the problems they face in their day-to-day work and try to influence the future of the field. Interactive working sessions will be the place where researchers meet practitioners to identify opportunities to create the future.

The theme of ICSA 2019 is "Architecting Systems of Systems" to draw special attention to the increasing size of software systems and the emergence of increasingly heterogeneous systems that is demanding for innovative software engineering practices.

Hamburg is the second largest city of Germany and the eighth largest city in the European Union with a population of over 1.7 million people. It is famous for its beautiful harbor, green landscape and cultural opportunities. The conference will be held in the Dorint Hotel Hamburg Eppendorf, right north of the heart of Hamburg, neighbouring the University Clinic.
